

<p><b>Agenda Items 3: Presentation -</b></p>	<p><b>Barbara Schneider Foundation:</b>                  Barbara died as a result of a mental health crisis/confrontation. Mr. Anderson is involved in:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• C.I.T. (Crisis Intervention Team) training, model started by Memphis Police Department</li> <li>• Partnership between first responder, mental health professionals, and community advocacy</li> <li>• More than a training (community-wide program)</li> <li>• De-escalation is important</li> <li>• Has been doing C.I.T. training with correction facilities (even implemented on Ryker’s Island)</li> <li>• Training hospitals and educators, also Native American population</li> <li>• Mental health issues are complicated</li> <li>• Challenge of first responder to overcome lack of trust of authority</li> <li>• De-escalation starts with crisis -- want to get to behavior change</li> <li>• Steps to accomplish this:                         <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Listening / Empathy / Rapport (trust) / influence = Behavior change                                 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ These model steps take time</li> </ul> </li> </ul> </li> <li>• Community people usually don’t have experience. <p><b>Agenda Item 4: Group Discussion on C.I.T. training for local law enforcement -</b></p>	<p><b>Q and A with Guests:</b>                  Actors are used in C.I.T. training, which is better than a video. C.I.T. = gold standard</p> <p>Sam: How do you determine how much C.I.T. training is enough? (Prioritize C.I.T. training as a high priority. What is the minimum?)</p> <p>Tony: They are looking into grants for C.I.T. training, de-escalation, slowing down so important.</p> <p>Tony: I would have one or two of us (LAC members) view this training so we know what we are recommending to the Commissioners.</p> <p>Tony: Law enforcement is usually called because crisis workers aren’t available.</p> <p>Sam: (Tony) is your training enough?</p> <p>Tony: We would like all of our officers to have at least some training.</p>	<p>Discussion</p>
