### **Former Chanhassen High School Principal, Timothy Dorway, Pled Guilty**

On June 1, 2017, former Chanhassen High School Principal, Timothy Dorway, entered guilty pleas to seven counts of possession of child pornography before the Honorable Janet Barke Cain pursuant to a plea agreement which requires him to serve a 60 month prison sentence. Pursuant to the Minnesota Sentencing Guidelines, Dorway will serve two-thirds or 40 months in prison and one-third or 20 months on supervised release. Dorway will be subject to five years of conditional release after his release from prison.

A sentencing hearing is set for July 26, 2017, at 1:30 p.m. at the Carver County Courthouse. Carver County Attorney Mark Metz will be available after sentencing for further comment.
