A Regular Session of the Carver County Board of Commissioners was held in the County Government Center, Chaska, on July 10, 2018. Chair Gayle Degler convened the session at 9:03 a.m.

Members present: Gayle Degler, Chair, Randy Maluchnik, Vice Chair, James Ische, Tim Lynch and Tom Workman.

Members absent: None.

Under public participation, Karen Johnson Leuthner, 15735 38th Street, Mayer, clarified she was not representing Carver County staff and was a relevant public watchdog. She stated she has been attending meetings for over a year questioning the actions done by County government and the Board has chosen to be silent instead of protecting citizens. She stated she was telling the truth and believed solar was one of the things going wrong. She questioned if additional antennas were being placed on the Hollywood Township Tower and that needed to stop.

Ische moved, Lynch seconded, to approve the agenda. Motion carried unanimously.

Maluchnik moved, Workman seconded, to approve the minutes of the June 19, 2018, Regular Session. Motion carried unanimously.

Ische moved, Lynch seconded, to approve the following consent agenda items:

Authorized receipt of \$100 donation for Encore.

Approved the purchase of Ford 350 truck and equipment from Waconia Ford and Crysteel Truck Equipment.

Resolution #52-18, Authorizing Settlement of Compensation to Owner for Acquisition of Real Property Interests Needed for the Highway 44 Bridge Project.

Approved a Use Permit to the West Metro Kids Against Hunger group to conduct the July 14, 2018, Tonka Mud Run event.

Approved a joint powers agreement with the City of Chaska for the County Road 10 corridor study pending finalization of the contract review process.

Resolution #53-18, Support and Approval for a BUILD grant application for US Highway 212 Expansion Between the City of Norwood Young America and Cologne.

Resolution #54-18, Support and Approval for a BUILD grant application for US Highway 212 Expansion Between the City of Cologne and Carver.

Authorized the Chair to sign the professional services agreement with the City of Chaska for stormwater retrofit cost share, pending completion of the contract review process.

Resolution #55-18, To Support the City of Chaska's Downtown Highway 41 and 61 Reconstruction Application.

Contract with LVC Companies pending completion of the County's contract review process.

Approved transfer of \$50,000 in auction proceeds to the Public Works Capital Equipment budget and related budget amendment.

Reviewed June 26, 2018, Community Social Services' actions/Commissioners' warrants in the amount of \$306,476.39; reviewed July 3, 2018, Community Social Services' actions/Commissioners' warrants in the amount of \$\$261,437.86 and reviewed July 10, 2018, Community Social Services' actions/Commissioners' warrants in the amount of \$\$327,007.30.

Motion carried unanimously.

Martin Walsh, Parks, appeared before the Board to review proposed operational plan for the Waconia Event Center. He pointed out the previous Board's direction to transition to a Town Hall model. He explained, since that time, the County has been successful in securing 1.5M from the Legislature for infrastructure improvements at the Lake Waconia Regional Park, to be matched with

1.5M of County resources. He noted there would be a significant disruption of services for these landscaping changes beginning in late summer 2019.

He explained a Town Hall Model would require minimal staffing and reviewed the responsibilities of the customer and county. Walsh stated they did pursue another tenant but they were unable to find a business model that would work. He noted this would be an interim approach due to the expected construction next year. He reviewed proposed fees to cover the costs and indicated a public hearing would be scheduled later on those fees.

Walsh indicated they would next propose to do a building study that would include a facility assessment and market research to support the building. He stated this would be funded by Parks professional services and they would report back to the Board on whether to move forward with additional services. He indicated they would also do additional scoping project work for the Regional Park infrastructure work and report back to the Board. He clarified the 1.5 grant from the Legislature could not be used for the structure itself.

Karen Johnson Leuthner inquired on the number that the facility could accommodate and suggested a fee be charged based on the number of people. She also suggested they reach out to wineries as to the possibility of continuing their evening events at the Event Center and the potential for other activities at this location.

Maluchnik moved, Ische seconded, to authorize staff to accept reservations, contingent on adoption and acceptance of the County Board amended 2018 Fee Schedule, for the following community events: Veterans Memorial Registry, Vintage Antique Snowmobile, Lions Wild Game Feed, and Ducks Unlimited Banquette and other events through July 31, 2019; to authorize staff to purchase tables and chairs for 300 at a cost not to exceed \$12K from WEC reserve funds and to authorize a building study of the Waconia Event Center to include a facility assessment/analysis and market research for a cost not to exceed \$17,500 funded by the Parks Department Budget Professional Services. Motion carried unanimously.

Dave Hemze, County Administrator, requested the Board approve the 2018-2019 Strategic Plan. He explained this was a roadmap for the organization and looks for opportunities and challenges. He indicated the vision, mission and goals remained the same and cited examples of initiatives completed over the past year.

Workman moved, Degler seconded, to adopt the 2018-2019 Strategic Plan. Motion carried unanimously.

Lynch moved, Ische seconded, to adjourn the Regular Session at 9:44 a.m. and convene as the Carver County Regional Rail Authority.

Martin Walsh, Parks, requested the Rail Authority authorize a letter of support to Scott County for the UP Trail Regional Solicitation application. He noted Scott County was a partner in purchasing the UP corridor. He identified the project location and indicated it was approximately two miles in length. He started this was consistent with the comp plan and consistent with the Regional Parks Policy Plan.

Ische moved, Workman seconded, to authorize a letter to Scott County in support of a Regional Solicitation application for the UP Trail/Minnesota River Bluffs Extension and Scott County Connection Regional Trail. Motion carried unanimously.

Walsh requested the Rail Authority adopt a Resolution to support regional solicitation funding for the City of Chaska's Circle the Brick Trail connection. He indicated the project included the section of the UP corridor from Athletic Park to Audubon Road. He added this was consistent with the City's trail plans and why the Rail Authority purchased the corridor.

Maluchnik offered the following Resolution, seconded by Degler:

- WHEREAS, the County, acting by and through its Board of Commissioners, is authorized by law, and pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, § 163.02, subd. 2; §117.012; and § 117.042, to acquire land and other real property interests in Carver County which the County needs for a public use or public purpose; and
- WHEREAS, the County proposes to construct highway and related improvements in Carver County for the Highway 140 Bridge Project Carver Creek East ("Project"); and
- WHEREAS, to complete the Project, the County must acquire the real property interests described in Exhibit A, attached hereto, from the Owners of the real property interests identified in said Exhibit A; and
- WHEREAS, the County obtained either an appraisal(s) from a licensed real estate appraiser when the estimate of the damages from the County's proposed acquisitions of the real property interests described in said Exhibit A exceeds \$25,000, or the County obtained a minimum damage acquisition report from a qualified person with appraisal knowledge, in lieu of an appraisal, when the estimate of the damages from the County's proposed acquisitions of the real property interests described in said Exhibit A is under \$25,000; and
- WHEREAS, County must determine and submit an initial written offer of just compensation to the Owners of said needed real property interests covering the full amount of damages caused by the County's proposed acquisitions; and
- WHEREAS, the Owners of said real property interests may obtain an independent appraisal by a qualified appraiser of the real property interests which the County proposes to acquire for the Project; and
- WHEREAS, the Owners of said real property interests are entitled to reimbursement for the reasonable costs of the appraisal from the County up to a maximum of the limits stated in Minn. Stat. §117.036, provided the Owner submits to County the information necessary for reimbursement; and
- WHEREAS, the Carver County Board of Commissioners authorized the Public Works Division Director or agents under his supervision, to make initial written offers of just compensation to the Owners within the Project from whom property interests are required; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Division Director or agents under his supervision, have negotiated set	ttlement(s)
with the Owners impacted by the project as described in said Exhibit A.	

- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that County's acquisition of the real property interests described in said Exhibit A and the construction of highway and related improvements of Bridge No. 10J33 as part of the Highway 140 Bridge Project Carver Creek East constitute a valid public use or public purpose; and
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that based upon the estimate of damages from the County's proposed acquisitions of the real property interests described in said Exhibit A which the County obtained either from an appraisal(s) or a minimum damage acquisition report(s) and the negotiations between said Owner(s) and the Public Works Division Director or agents under his supervision, County shall make a payment of compensation to the Owners within the Project from whom the County must acquire needed real property interests, in the amounts as described in said Exhibit A; and
