

PROTECTING LAKES, RIVERS & STREAMS

Proper disposal of yard waste impacts the health of local waterways. You can make a significant impact by taking these steps.

- Don't blow or rake grass clippings and leaves into the street or waterways. Leave them on your lawn, compost them or bag them up.
- Pick up pet waste and put it in the garbage. Don't put pet waste in your compost.
- Use phosphorus-free fertilizer to help prevent rapid algae growth in our rivers and lakes. Sweep up fertilizer spills from hard surfaces.
- Direct gutter downspouts into your lawns, gardens or rain barrels.
- Keep a healthy and low maintenance lawn. Mow at a higher setting or plant no-mow grass.
- Plant native flowers and plants and consider installing a raingarden.



ASH TREE WASTE TRANSPORT & DISPOSAL

The emerald ash borer is a destructive tree pest that attacks and kills ash trees. To prevent the spread of the emerald ash borer, a quarantine is in place for select counties in Minnesota. Waste from ash trees cannot be hauled out of the contiguous quarantine areas. Some waste haulers and sites cannot accept ash tree waste.

Ash tree waste should be taken to the closest disposal site within the quarantine area to minimize the spread of emerald ash borer. For more information visit: mda.state.mn.us/eab

Yard waste—such as grass clippings, leaves and branches—is a valuable resource that can add nutrients into your yard or be recycled into compost.

PRIVATE HAULER CURBSIDE SERVICE

COMPOSTABLE BAG LAW DID YOU KNOW?

Per State law, residents in the Twin Cities area who bag their yard and organic waste are required to put their waste out for pickup in certified compostable bags—either paper bags or compostable plastic bags.

Plastic bags can be used when delivering yard and organic waste to a drop-off site, however, material must be de-bagged. Plastic bags should be reused or disposed of through residential garbage service.
