SCHOOL, BUSINESS, ORGANIZATION RECYCLING GRANT OPPORTUNITY



Carver County provides GRANT FUNDING to schools, businesses, and organizations to reduce waste, design a new or improved recycling program, or start organics recycling. No funding match is required.

Who is eligible?

Schools, businesses, and organizations located in Carver County.

Items covered

- Recycling and organics bins
- Recycling equipment purchases
- Educational materials
- Initial supply of BPI-certified compostable products
- Initial organics hauling service charges (traditional recycling hauling service charges are not eligible)
- Reusable service ware
- And more

If grant funding is available, a Carver County staff member will contact you and assist with completing a funding application. Grant awards are available up to \$2,500. Organics projects may exceed \$2,500 with permission from Carver County. Grant applications will be reviewed and awarded on a first-come, first-served basis. Funding is limited. Funding for most items is disbursed via reimbursement.
