<p>Agenda Item 6:</p>	<p>Guests: Don Amarosi shared info on money available to train police through the state for mental health training. Dr. Scott shared the counties challenges in meeting the mental health needs of the community yet he emphasized how important it is. Commissioner Randy Maluchnik shared work in the jails & the county attorney has recommended a “drug court”. Commissioner Maluchnik recommended having the county attorney report to the LAC once a year and also have the sheriff come to meet with the LAC once a year.</p>		<p>Information</p>
<p>Agenda Item 7:</p>	<p>Old Business: Vitals App Discussion-Eddie no longer has HIPAA concerns, but has concerns regarding keeping information confidential and regarding police using information correctly. Garret Zayic shared that the app is free & the cost is absorbed by the police department. Families get one “beacon” free and must pay \$20 per beacon for additional beacons. Garret also shared that you do not need smart phones and that if an individual quits the data is purged. There was much discussion about Vitals. Next month we’ll vote on whether we recommend Vitals. Derek will try to get the sheriff to attend next meeting. Ana voiced disappointment regarding postponing vote. Derek asked Melissa if we can schedule Dr Plotnikoff October 1,2 or 3?
