

## **Execution Instruction Sheet**

It is not the responsibility of the Sheriff's Office to locate the assets of the Judgment Debtor. Sheriff's Office fees and legal fees will be added to the execution.

## To levy on a debtor's wages, you will need to do the following:

- 1. Mail an Execution Exemption notice to the last known address (10) days prior to the delivery of the writ to the Sheriff's Office
- 2. Endorse the original execution
- 3. Enclose a \$110.00 check made payable to Carver County
- 4. Enclose a \$15.00 check made payable to the employer for the legal fee
- 5. Provide the name and address of the employer

## To levy on a bank account, you will need to do the following:

- 1. Endorse the original execution
- 2. Enclose a \$110.00 check made payable to Carver County
- 3. Enclose a \$15.00 check made payable to the financial institution for the legal fee
- 4. If the judgment is against an individual, provide (2) exemption notices to be served
- 5. Provide the name and address of the financial institution
