BACKGROUND/JUSTIFICATION: The Metropolitan Council is updating Regional Parks Policy Plan; one of the elements of the update is the consideration of new parks and trails units to the system. The plan is to be written and ready to post for public hearing in July. In order to meet that deadline, proposed system addition proposals must be received by April 30, 2014 so they can be analyzed and discussed by the Metropolitan Parks and Open Space Commission and the Community Development Committee. Carver County Park Staff will meet with city park agencies of the county on Thursday, April 17, 2014 to discuss trails which might be considered for inclusion into the regional park and trail system. Staff will report on any suggested regional trail additions or alterations to existing planned regional trail alignments. It is not contemplated that additional regional park areas would be requested in addition to the future regional park search areas already identified in the County Comprehensive Plan and the Metropolitan Council's Park Open Space and Trails Plan.

BACKGROUND/JUSTIFICATION: Carver County Public Health was awarded a Statewide Health Improvement Program (SHIP) grant in November 2013. SHIP strives to help Minnesotans lead longer, healthier lives by preventing the chronic disease risk factors of tobacco use and exposure, poor nutrition, and physical inactivity, with an emphasis on populations experiencing health disparities and/or inequities. SHIP seeks to create sustainable, systemic changes in schools, worksites, communities, child care, and health care organizations that make it easier for Minnesotans to incorporate healthy behaviors into their daily lives. This cycle of the SHIP grant is divided into two phases, with two separate grants: Planning and Implementation. The Planning grant amount is \$100,000 for the period November 1, 2013 through June 30, 2014. During the Planning phase Public Health is assessing community needs and readiness, building capacity for implementation, and engaging organizations who work with populations experiencing health inequities. Public Health staff is developing plans to successfully implement nine (9) strategies to improve healthy eating and physical activity, and reduce tobacco use and secondhand smoke exposure in Carver County. Public Health staff would like to update the County Board of Commissioners on SHIP work to date and next steps in developing the SHIP Implementation grant application for the period July 1, 2014 to October 31, 2015. The Implementation grant amount will be \$272,234.
