BACKGROUND/JUSTIFICATION:			
Independent School District (ISD) 108, Central Schools of Norwood Young America, has requested a special use permit for upcoming cross county running meets planned for August 27, September 3 & 24 and October 8 to be held at Baylor Regional Park.			
By County Ordinance, Chapter 91; special events require issuance of a use permit.			
The four planned meets are consistent with State Executive Order(s) and Minnesota State High School League (MSHSL) guidelines for how high school cross country athletics are to be performed under COVID19 guidelines. The permittee has prepared and submitted a preparedness plan specific to team operations (including daily practice and meets) as well as site details for when County park property is used for meets.			
In past years, these events have attracted 1000's of people (athletes, faculty, spectators). Under the guidelines and review and comment from the State, MSHSL and County Public Health & Attorney's Office, each event is limited in total to two hundred and Fifty (250) people, where at no time can groups congregate greater than twenty five (25) in one area (i.e. start and finish areas, team areas etc.).			
The meets are organized and facilitated by athletic faculty of ISD 108 in coordination with their athletic conference. Appropriate insurance certificates and other permit requirements have been provided to the County by ISD 108.			
These events have a long history of being very successfully organized by the permittee on County park property. With approval, these would be the first special use/event occurrences on County Park property since the COVID19 pandemic.			
The Park Commission is expected to recommend approval of the request for board action on August 12, 2020.			
Staff of ISD 108 is aware that should COVID19 guidelines and requirements change, corresponding changes to the permit may also apply.
