Common Acronyms and Definitions

AC Program = Alternative Care Provides funding for home and community-based services for persons 65 years and over, who are at risk of nursing home placement and have low levels of income and assets.

ADL= Activity of Daily Living Personal care activities necessary for everyday living, such as eating, bathing, grooming, dressing and toileting. Frequently used in assessments.

BS=Background Study All employees must pass in order to work on CDCS.

CAC Waiver= Community Alternative Care Providers funding for home and community-based services for chronically ill and medically fragile persons who need the level of the care provided in a hospital.

CADI Waiver=Community Access for Disability Inclusion Waiver Provides funding for home and community-based services for persons with disabilities who require the level of care provided in a nursing facility.

CDCS=Community Directed Community Supports Service option that gives persons more flexibility and responsibility for directing their services and supports, including hiring and managing direct care staff and purchasing goods and services.

CM=Case Manager Person whose job it is to assess client needs, coordinate, monitor, evaluate and advocate for services. Required on a Waiver.

Consumer/Client=the person receiving services

CSG= Consumer Support Grant MA funded self-directed grant alternative for those qualifying for PCA Services, home health aide or nursing services.

CSP=Consumer Support Plan Self-directed plan completed to implement CDCS Waiver. Not to be confused with a the MnChoice Assessment Community Support Plan (CSP).

DD Waiver=Developmental Disabilities Waiver Providers funding for home and community-based services for person with a developmental disability or related condition who need the level of care provided in an Intermediate Care Facility for person with Developmental Disabilities (ICF/DD).

DHS=Department of Human Services (Minnesota State Department)

FEIN=Federal Employer Identification Number Need to apply for this with Payroll/FEA Model.

FMS=Financial Management Services Agency you choose to handle administrative duties on your behalf (billing the state) including payroll, hiring employees, etc. Formally know as FSE.

EW Waiver= Elderly Waiver Provides funding for home and community base services for people over the age of 65 years who require the level of care provided in a nursing facility.

LTCC=Long Term Care Consultation Assessment used to determine services needed for people to stay in their homes and receive long- term care services.

MA=Medical Assistance Publicly funded health care program providing coverage for low income or disabled individuals.

MnChoice Assessment= Annual assessment conducted to determine eligibility and CDCS budget amount.

MnSure= Minnesota's health insurance marketplace where individuals and families can shop, compare and choose health insurance coverage. Cannot be on this and be on a waiver.

PCA= Personal Care Assistant The caregiver hired through licensed PCA agency.

PDN=Private Duty Nursing

PHN=Public Health Nursing

PPOM/Spouse=Paid Parent of a Minor or Spouse Parents and spouses paid to care for their love one.

PTO= Paid Time Off Accrue 1 hour for every 40 hours worked per union contract.

Primary Caregiver Relief= Short Term care provided in the home or other location allowing primary caregivers a break from direct care.

RN/LPN= Registered nurse/Licensed practical nurse

MP=Managing Party Person designated to make decisions for the consumer. Sometimes this is the consumer themselves.

SEIU=Service Employee International Union Negotiates employee benefits with DHS (e.g. paid time off)

SP=Support Planner Person you may hire to help write your CDCS Consumer Support Plan

Support Staff= Staff hired to work with client/consumer

TB Waiver= Traumatic Brain Injury Waiver Provides funding for home and community-based services for children and adults who have acquired or traumatic brain injury.

TEFRA=Tax Equity Fiscal Responsibility Act Medical Assistance for children with disabilities, the parental fee.

UMPI Number= Unique Minnesota Provider Identifier All employees must apply for this through MN Department of Human Services. Tracks number of hours worked across agencies.
