 - a. Pay structure evaluation
 - i. Short staffing
 - 1. Hiring another therapist
 - 2. Getting more patients
 - 3. Challenge is Psychiatry
 - a. Contracts with Innovatel
 - i. Have an ad on Indeed
 - ii. Carver Co does not want to backfill
 - iii. Telehealth providers are easier to obtain
 - 4. Both in house psychiatrists are past retirement age
 - a. Need to be secure in that area as time moves forward
 - 5. Is it a facility issue?
 - a. Low graduation #'s
 - b. Salary (compared well with other psychiatrists, but now not sure)
 - c. Backup/multiple psychiatrists on duty
 - d. It might be a good idea to partner with other providers
 - i. Partnering with church or Ridgeview psychiatry
 - b. An advance practice or prescribing nurse would have similar duties but Carver Co see our most mentally ill individuals, where most clients need a medical doctor

- c. Required to have a medical doctor on staff
- d. May have hospital admitting purposes
- e. Have more access to advanced practice nurses-through the telehealth company we have two
 - i. Could fall to this if needed but more medical training is needed
 - ii. Our 2 LPN's do not prescribe
- 2. Mary-would love to hear more about how the mental health Sheriff liaison/co responder is working out
 - a. Feels we will be seeing more and more of this
 - b. What's working and what is not
 - Melanie-the co responder is currently doing a big database integration/update;
 statewide they are working on a program structure & Melanie is participating in these workgroups
 - i. Derek wants context around numbers
 - ii. Mary feels this is a growing area
- 3. Stigma 180 (Madeline)
 - a. Talks about mental health and school aged children
 - b. Lindsey would be happy to be a point person to talk to her about how we can be more integrated with the schools
 - c. 2020 put a pause on our relationship with the school districts
- 4. Law Enforcement Presence on council
- 5. Increased Minority Presence on council
- 6. Chat bot on website/technology evaluation
- 7. Outreach to the community-encourage individuals who provide mental health services to come to meetings
- 8. Intensive Mental Health Treatment
 - a. Steiner-Kelting Residential crisis stabilization facility
 - b. It was supposed to go live last year
 - c. People Incorporated is the contractor
 - d. Should be open in 2021
 - i. Not for violent criminals
 - ii. Nothing that poses a threat to the school
- 9. As the county grows we have to start talking about a new brick and mortar facility instead of Waconia
- 10. Pick up on children's side of things
 - a. There is a great need
 - b. Lindsey-Prairie care was backed up, not enough beds available
 - c. We need to find ways to increase access to beds, it is our role to be involved in that
