The plan has been sent to the City of Chanhassen and was received back with minimal comments and is ready for a building permit request. The main components of the project are an 80 amp natural gas fired generator (22kW), associated switch gear and circuitry rewires. And is not transferable to another person or to another parcel of property.

Purpose of Certificate: To certify that the permittee and/or organization to which this certificate is issued is permitted and authorized to hold a Maifest Celebration event on Sunday, May 19, 2013. The event shall take place in Watertown Township in accordance with the conditions listed on this permit and in accordance with Chapter 152, Section 152.074 B6 of the Carver County Code.



Administrative Policy Manual 2013 Updates

Policy: County Auctions

A. Broaden policy to include disposal of all assets including auction, bids, trade-in, scrap, salvage, revenue contracts and sale of unique items by obtaining multiple quotes.

Policy: Government Ethics

A. Only "de minimus" gifts are allowed (generally less than \$5 or the occasional plaque).

Policy: Carver County Donations

- A. Add language about the County accepting donations that are used for prizes.
 - a. County Board must accept all donations.
 - i. If County employees are eligible, the prize must be under \$5.
- B. Add language allowing County promotional drawings/handouts/giveaways.
 - a. Individual items under \$5 can be donated with the approval of the Division Director (pencils, magnets, etc.)
 - b. Individual items over \$5 must be approved by the County Board (park passes, rain barrels, etc.)

Policy: Contracts and Purchasing

- A. Add additional language supporting and clarifying best value bidding.
- B. Clean up some procedure language.

Policy: Local Preference

- A. Solicit bids from local businesses
- B. Tie goes to local business
- C. In certain cases, local business allowed to match the price if they are within a certain percentage of low price.

Policy: Use of Meeting Rooms (Change title to Meeting Rooms and Facility Use)

Updates: Include language about use of facility for outside groups for displays, drop boxes etc.

Policy: Tobacco Use

Updates: No tobacco use on county grounds except for designated areas.

Policy: Computer Hardware, Software and Telecommunications

Updates: Revamp policy including cell phone options and email retention.

Policy: Data Requests

Updates: New form.

Policy: Cyber Security

Updates: New policy aimed at limiting the County's exposure to cyber threats.
