A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE THE HIGHWAY 11 CORRIDOR STUDY

WHEREAS, the City of Victoria and Carver County are responsible for the planning and development of a safe and functional multimodal transportation system within their jurisdictional boundaries and the City's anticipated growth area within Laketown Township; and

WHEREAS, the City of Victoria partnered with Carver County to identify transportation system improvements on County State Aid Highway (CSAH) 11/Victoria Dr. from CSAH 10/Engler Blvd. to south of CSAH 14/Pioneer Trail/Marsh Lake Rd. to serve development driven highway needs; and

WHEREAS, the Highway 11 Corridor Study recommends roadway concept improvements including: roadway typical section and right of way impact alternatives and access type and location alternatives to serve short, mid, and long-term development and infrastructure needs; and

WHEREAS, the Highway 11 Corridor Study includes an implementation plan and estimated improvement costs to guide City of Victoria and Carver County capital improvement planning for development driven improvements along the CSAH 11 corridor; and

WHEREAS, the City of Victoria recognizes that the recommended planning level alternatives establish a future vision for agencies to jointly work towards, noting additional design and environmental review will be required.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of Victoria does hereby support the findings, recommended improvements, and the proposed implementation plan of the Highway 11 Corridor Study as a plan to guide development and future investments in the project area.
