# Resolution Authorizing Final Offers of Compensation to Landowners for Easements Required for the TH 101 Bridge and CSAH 61 'Y' Intersection Project Also Known As the Southwest Reconnection Project

- WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Carver County is the official governing body of Carver County ("County"); and
- WHEREAS, the County, acting by and through its Board of Commissioners, is authorized by law to acquire land and other interests in real estate which are needed for public use or purpose; and
- WHEREAS, Carver County wishes to construct roadway and related improvements as part of the TH 101 Bridge and CSAH 61 "Y" Intersection Project aka The Southwest Reconnection Project ("Project"); and
- WHEREAS, in order to complete the Project it is necessary for the County to purchase property interests from each of the properties described in <a href="Exhibit A">Exhibit A</a> attached hereto (the "Properties"); and
- WHEREAS, the County has retained independent real estate appraisers to provide the County with the appraisers' estimates of the damages caused by the County's acquisition of the property interests required for the Project; and
- WHEREAS, pursuant to those appraisals, the County made offers of compensation to the owners of the Properties for the needed property interests consistent with the appraiser's estimate of the damages being incurred by the various owners as a result of the County's acquisitions, but despite their best efforts, representatives of the County have been unable to reach agreement with the owners of the Properties concerning the amount of compensation to be paid for the required property interests; and
- WHEREAS, the Director of Public Works has advised the Board of Commissioners that it is likely to be necessary for the County to undertake eminent domain proceedings to acquire the property interests over the Properties which are required for the Project, and that it is advisable to make final offers of compensation to those owners prior to commencing eminent domain proceedings;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Carver County Board of Commissioners as follows:

- 1. The Board of Commissioners finds that it is necessary and for a public purpose for the County to acquire the property interests described in <a href="Exhibit A">Exhibit A</a> for the Project.
- 2. Based upon appraisals obtained by the County from independent real estate appraisers and the advice of counsel, the Director of Public Works or agents under his supervision shall make written final offers of compensation to the owners of the Properties, in the amounts determined by the Director of Public Works, which total an aggregate amount of \$522,210 for Parcels 4, 6, 11A, 12A, 15, 22, 25, 34 and 36.

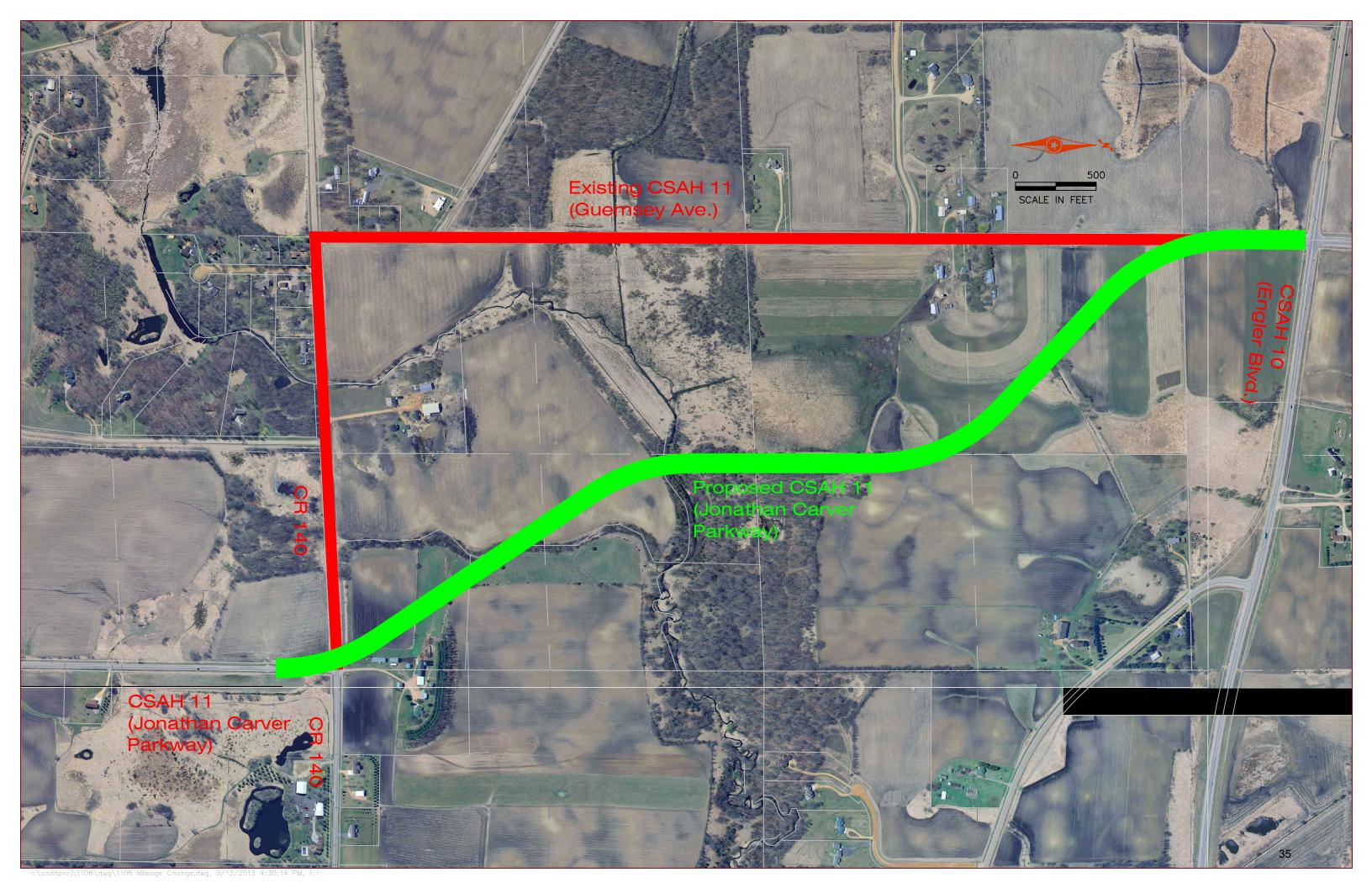
