	Are we able to track if they are drug or alcohol related calls at the time of assessment. If they are impaired, Alyson waits to assess	
	They are clear enough to be able to be assessed	
	She has not been any positions where she feels unsafe	
	She feels the officers have done well to ensure she goes to a safe spot Alyson gets them out quickly	
	There are more of these programs coming up across counties but not continuity on how things are done	
	Of the encounters, how many went to the hospital 10-20% and they have not always had to do a 72 hour hold or inpatient	
	Feels the Emergency Room has been helpful	
	What happens if Alyson gets another call while she is with a client **They always have the option of calling crisis and requesting a clinician meet them **might dispatch a bit slower
