BACKGROUND/JUSTIFICATION:					

CarverLink staff will provide a brief update on its activities over the past year and then present the Connect Up Carver Initiative. The Connect Up Carver Initiative is a project that would utilize American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funding to collaborate in a public/private partnership between the County and a service provider to provide the availability of fiber connectivity to all identified remaining under/unserved residential/business appropriate addresses in the County where fiber connectivity availability is not already provided or planned for availability in the near future. It specifically provides the availability of fiber connectivity to the locations in Carver County that are not currently economically viable for any service providers to build out and provide high speed wired services at symmetrical upload/download speeds of no less than 100MB up/down.

The project would leverage the existing CarverLink infrastructure to construct additional middle mile fiber to locations in the County (primarily rural) that are identified by US Treasury Rules relating to the use of ARPA funds for broadband activities to under/unserved residents that in parallel with other collaborations and initiatives that CarverLink is actively participating in, would provide ubiquitous fiber coverage to everyone in Carver County that wants it. CarverLink would partner with the existing or if appropriate, new service providers in our network and utilize our existing agreements and maintenance arrangements to efficiently and effectively implement the network and we would manage and operate the new fiber infrastructure in the same manner and use as the current CarverLink infrastructure that is in use today.
