Lynch nominated Gayle Degler to serve as Chair of the Board of Commissioners for 2022.

Hearing no other nominations, Administrator Hemze closed nominations.

On vote taken to elect Tom Workman to serve as Chair of the Board of Commissioners for 2022 with a rotating gavel by Commissioner District, Udermann, Workman voted aye. Degler, Fahey, Lynch voted nay. Motion failed.

On vote taken to elect Gayle Degler to serve as Chair of the Board of Commissioners for 2022, Degler, Fahey, Lynch voted aye. Udermann, Workman voted nay. Motion carried.

Chair Degler requested nominations for Vice Chair. Udermann nominated Tom Workman as Vice Chair of the Board of Commissioners for 2022. Lynch nominated John Fahey as Vice Chair of the Board of Commissioners for 2022.

On vote taken to elect Tom Workman as Vice Chair for 2022, Udermann voted aye. Degler, Fahey, Lynch, Workman voted nay. Motion failed.

On vote taken to elect John Fahey as Vice Chair for 2022, Degler, Fahey, Lynch, Workman voted aye. Udermann voted nay. Motion carried.

Resolution Authorizing Settlement of Compensation to Owners for Acquisition of Real Property Interests Needed for Highway 10 Project – North Watertown

- WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Carver County is the official governing body of Carver County ("County"); and
- WHEREAS, the County, acting by and through its Board of Commissioners, is authorized by law, and pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, § 163.02, subd. 2; §117.012; and § 117.042, to acquire land and other real property interests in Carver County which the County needs for a public use or public purpose; and
- WHEREAS, the County proposes to construct highway and related improvements in Carver County for shoulder widening as part of the Highway 10 Project North Watertown ("Project"); and
- WHEREAS, to complete the Project, the County must acquire the real property interests described in Exhibit A, attached hereto, from the Owners of the real property interests identified in said Exhibit A; and
- WHEREAS, the County obtained either an appraisal(s) from a licensed real estate appraiser when the estimate of the damages from the County's proposed acquisitions of the real property interests described in said Exhibit A exceeds \$25,000, or the County obtained a minimum damage acquisition report from a qualified person with appraisal knowledge, in lieu of an appraisal, when the estimate of the damages from the County's proposed acquisitions of the real property interests described in said Exhibit A is under \$25,000; and
- WHEREAS, County must determine and submit an initial written offer of just compensation to the Owners of said needed real property interests covering the full amount of damages caused by the County's proposed acquisitions; and
- WHEREAS, the Owners of said real property interests may obtain an independent appraisal by a qualified appraiser of the real property interests which the County proposes to acquire for the Project; and
- WHEREAS, the Owners of said real property interests are entitled to reimbursement for the reasonable costs of the appraisal from the County up to a maximum of the limits stated in Minn. Stat. §117.036, provided the Owner submits to County the information necessary for reimbursement; and
- WHEREAS, the Carver County Board of Commissioners authorized the Public Works Division Director or agents under his supervision, to make initial written offers of just compensation to the Owners within the Project from whom property interests are required; and

, the Public Works Division Director or agents under his supervision, have negotiated settlement(s) with the Owners impacted by the Project as described in said Exhibit A.
REFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that County's acquisition of the real property interests described in said Exhibit A and the construction of highway and related improvements of shoulder widening as part of the Highway 10 Project – North Watertown constitute a valid public use or public purpose; and
THER RESOLVED that based upon the estimate of damages from the County's proposed acquisitions of the real property interests described in said Exhibit A which the County obtained either from an appraisal(s) or a minimum damage acquisition report(s) and the negotiations between said Owner(s) and the Public Works Division Director or agents under his supervision. County shall make a payment

and the Public Works Division Director or agents under his supervision, County shall make a payment of compensation to the Owners within the Project from whom the County must acquire needed real property interests, in the amounts as described in said Exhibit A; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Carver County Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes and directs

the Carver County Board Chairman and Carver County Administrator to enter into Stipulation of Settlement Agreement with said property owner(s), in the name of the County of Carver for the Project.

Dear Chair Hovland and TAB Members,

Thank you for the opportunity to review and comment on the 2040 Transportation Policy Plan 2020 Update (Plan) Amendment under consideration by the Metropolitan Council, which identifies policies and plans to guide the development of the region's transportation system.

The proposed Plan Amendment includes the recommendation to add six highway freight projects to the Current Revenue Scenario. These freight projects were selected for federal transportation funding awards as the result of MnDOT's Minnesota Highway Freight Program, a competitive statewide program that allocates federal transportation funding to construction projects on public roads that provide measurable freight transportation benefits.

The Highway 212 Rural Freight Mobility and Safety Project in Carver County is one of the six freight projects selected in MnDOT's Minnesota Highway Freight Program for federal transportation funding with an award of \$7.5 million. The project will reconstruct and expand Highway 212 between Norwood Young America and Cologne from a two-lane rural highway to a four-lane divided expressway and include overdue intersection safety improvements. The proposed improvements will remove barriers to efficient freight movement, provide economic development opportunities at key locations, preserve existing infrastructure, and improve the corridor's mobility and safety for all users.

Carver County fully supports the inclusion and adoption of the six freight projects selected in MnDOT's Minnesota Highway Freight Program, including Highway 212 Rural Freight Mobility and Safety Project, as presented in the Metropolitan Council's proposed Plan amendment.

ORDINANCE 98-2022

AN ORDINANCE IMPOSING SLOW-NO WAKE WATERCRAFT RESTRICTIONS ON DESIGNATED LAKES

THE COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF CARVER COUNTY, MINNESOTA HEREBY ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. TITLE.

This ordinance shall be known, cited, and referred to as the Carver County Slow-No Wake Ordinance.

SECTION 2. DEFINITIONS.

Terms used in this ordinance related to boating are defined in Minnesota Statutes §86B.005.

SECTION 3. STATUORY AUTHORIZATION AND PURPOSE.

- (A) This Ordinance is enacted under the general powers delegated to the Counties by the State of Minnesota, pursuant to Minn. Stat. §§ 375.51, 86B.205, and 459.20, and Minnesota Rules 6110.3000-6110.3800 as now in effect and as hereafter amended.
- (B) It is the intent and purpose of this Ordinance to:
 - (1) To promote the full use and enjoyment by all of the people, now and in the future, and to promote safety for all persons and property in connection with the use of waters of Carver County;
 - (2) To conserve the quality of the natural environment;
 - (3) To harmonize and integrate the varying uses of said waters; and
 - (4) To promote the general health, safety, and welfare of the general public.

SECTION 4. DECLARACTION AND DESIGNATED LAKES.

- (A) The County Board of Commissioners declares a high water emergency on the Designated Lakes as defined by Section 4(B) and imposes a Slow-No Wake restriction pursuant to Minnesota Rule 6110.3700, Subpart 9.
- (B) Designated Lakes. This Ordinance shall control and regulate the use of the waters of the following lakes located in Carver County along with the following triggers:

SECTION 5. WATERCRAFT SPEED RESTRICTIONS.

During the period this Ordinance is in effect, including any extensions herein, it shall be unlawful for any person to operate a watercraft at greater than a slow-no wake speed (5 miles per hour), 24 hours per day within the Slow-No Wake restriction area specified on any Designated Lake.

SECTION 6. REMOVAL OF SPEED RESTRICTIONS.

The_Slow-No Wake Restrictions shall be promptly removed from any Designated Lake, pursuant to this Ordinance, once the water body has been 0.1 feet below the elevation that triggers the Slow-No Wake Restriction for three (3) consecutive days.

SECTION 7. ENFORCEMENT.

The primary responsibility for enforcement of this Ordinance shall rest with the Carver County Sheriff's Office. Other licensed peace officers, including conservation officers of the Minnesota Department of Natural Resources, are also authorized to enforce the provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 8. PENALTY.

A person guilty of violating any provision of this chapter shall be guilty of a misdemeanor pursuant to M.S. § 398.34 and as defined in M.S. § 609.02(3), as they may be amended from time to time.

SECTION 9. EXCEPTIONS.


All authorized Resource Management, Emergency and Enforcement Personnel, while acting in the performance of their assigned duties, are exempt from the foregoing restrictions.

SECTION 10. NOTIFICATION.

It shall be the responsibility of Carver County to provide for adequate notification to the public, which shall include notification on its website and news releases. Carver County is also responsible for placement of a sign at each Designated Lake public watercraft access, outlining essential elements of this Ordinance.

SECTION 11. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This Ordinance shall be effective upon passage by the Carver County Board of Commissioners.

BACKGROUND/JUSTIFICATION: The 2022 construction season includes the Highway 24 Project which is the pavement rehabilitation and shoulder widening of the highway from Highway 10 to the Hennepin County border. Additional right-of-way is needed to complete the project scope. Carver County has contracted with appraisers in order to establish fair market value for the right of way acquisitions needed in support of the project. On July 13, 2021, the County Board authorized Public Works staff to make offers for direct purchase of the impacted properties. Minnesota Statutes Section 117.031 provides that the condemning authority may make a last written offer of compensation prior to filing a Petition for Eminent Domain. A court may award reasonable attorney fees, expenses, and other costs and fees depending on how much greater the final judgment or award is than the last written offer. Out of a total of fifty two (52) impacted parcels, twenty six(26) property owners have executed settlement agreements. Prior to initiating the petition for eminent domain process, Public Works staff recommended the County Board direct the Public Works Director to make last written offers of compensation to twenty (21) remaining parcel owners at a previous closed session on January 4, 2022. However, 3 parcels were inadvertently left out of the discussion. Those properties are located at PID #'s 100121250; 100121200, 100100600. These three parcels will be discussed in closed session.
