BACKGROUND/JUSTIFICATION:					
The CDA is requesting the County Board to pledge its General Obligation to a CDA Bond Sale which will be used to purchase a senior building in the County. The CDA plans to purchase Waybury, a 114 unit senior apartment building, in Chaska. The CDA and its financial consultant will be at the workshop to provide more information. At the same time to save issuance costs, Finance is recommending the Board authorize a Bond Sale for the County's \$1.4M contribution to the Engler Blvd Project. The debt service is expected to be paid for by the creation of the County's second tax abatement district. It is expected that three public hearings will need to be held for these projects.
