BACKGROUND/JUSTIFICATION: Since 2009 staff have been working with adjacent landowners along the Dakota Rail corridor to resolve encroachment issues. Many of the adjacent landowners have complied with the requests to remove items from railroad property. Adjacent landowners also have a history of mowing, haying and landscaping the Carver County Regional Rail Authority property. Additionally, Staff continues to receive requests from landowners who would like to be allowed to make improvements on the railroad property. Examples of these improvements include, landscaping, drainage mowing to create a manicured appearance, and installation of private accesses to the railroad property/ trail. Some landowners continue to use the Carver County Regional Rail Authority property for storage which can be unsightly. Storage issues along the corridor include: shed/kennel, yard waste, outdoor storage (cars, campers and other miscellaneous items). Additional, farming and private signage are other examples of encroachments. Staff will present information about the encroachment issues and also discuss a simple permitting process for allowed uses of railroad property. ACTION REQUESTED: No action is requested at this time, Staff is seeking feedback from the Board on what activities the board would allow on railroad property to implement a permit system for allowed activities. Staff is also seeking guidance for how to deal with encroachments that the Board may not support.
