	Beth Fagin: School has ended so everyone is taking some deep breaths and winding up for the summer program that starts next week. End of year was status quo, once school is out the number of times someone wants to be seen diminishes. Sometimes staff still check in with kids PREP Adventure is a 6-week program that it turned out to be such a positive experience Kids learn a skill and do an activity and practice what they learn with peers Groups of ten kids to practice skills They choose kids for these programs that are often dysregulated and not going to summer camps They are on their way Hoping next school year is less stressful and closer to the normal Everyone in education has gone through this traumatic experience with COVID Any opportunity we have to get together with social groups is good for us There are more dysregulated kids because of the covid restrictions Dating and prom were thrown off because of COVID Example of skills they are using in the park-Waiting their turn Archery-they need to wait their turn Opportunity to give immediate feedback	
	Stephanie Combey: Crisis is still quite busy Many referrals for young people getting services Continuing to support adults as well Transition to 988 happens in July and there is an anticipation of increased call volume
