### Fibers

- Brown grocery bags
- Beer & soda cases
- Cereal & snack boxes
- Cardboard (non-waxed)
- Catalogs & magazines
- Office / school paper (all colors)
- Newspaper, junk mail & inserts
- Soft cover books
- Cartons

### Plastics

- Berry containers
- Juice containers
- Milk jugs
- Water bottles
- Food containers #1, #2, #5
- Beverage containers #1, #2, #5

### Metal & Glass

- Aluminum cans
- Steel cans
- Beer & wine bottles
- Other food and beverage containers made of glass or metal

## Materials Not Accepted



### Not Accepted

- Appliances
- Automotive, window & mirror glass
- Batteries of any kind
- Ceramics
- Diapers
- Dishware
- Drinking glasses
- Electronics (TVs, Phones, etc.)
- Extension chords & Christmas lights
- Food waste/ organic materials
- Glass bakeware / cookware
- Household garbage
- Hazardous chemical containers
- Light bulbs & fluorescent bulbs
- Medical waste
- Microwave trays
- Needles & syringes
- Packing peanuts / foam
- Paper products with food residue
- Plastic / canvas tarps
- Plastic / wood clothes hangers

## Special Waste Materials Accepted



### Accepted

- Antifreeze
- Plastic bags, film & wrap
- Motor oil  
(empty containers must be taken home and thrown in the trash)
- Oil filters (remove from packaging & throw packing in trash)
- Scrap Metal (metal ONLY)
