Discussion of other underserved populations, immigrant populations, and importance of integrating trauma informed approaches, CLAS standards. How to reach people in rural settings and the needs and gaps were discussed. Transportation barriers and basic needs not being met were discussed. In person outreach has been limited during COVID-19.
