

HIGHWAY 41/10 PROJECT

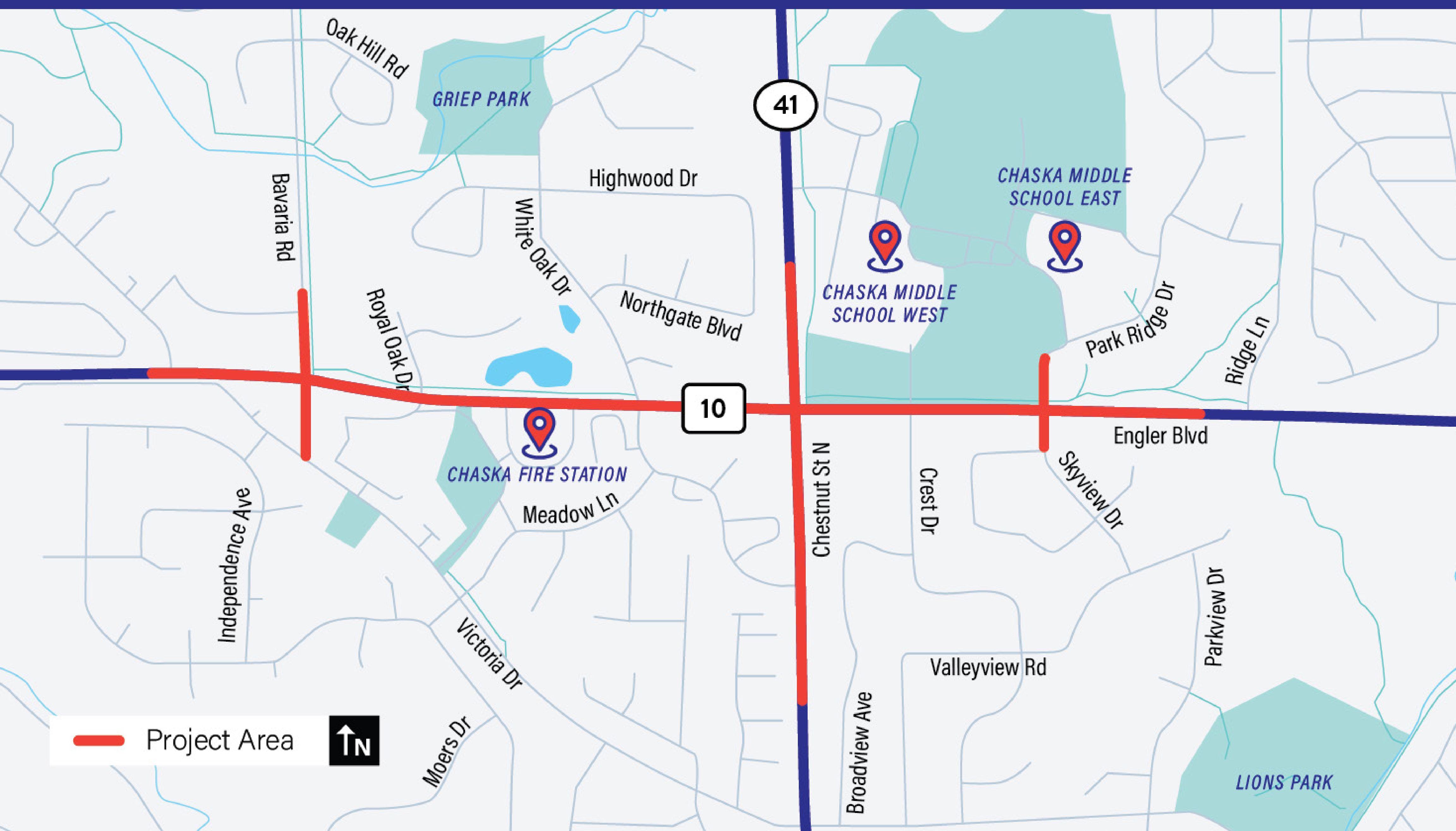


Carver County, in collaboration with MnDOT and the City of Chaska, is working to identify transportation system improvements on Highway 10/Engler Boulevard from Bavaria Road to Park Ridge Drive in Chaska. Highway 10 provides connections to multiple Carver County communities and is used by residents, commuters, freight traffic, pedestrians, and bicyclists.

This project will identify transportation problems and develop, evaluate, and implement improvements along Highway 10 and at the Highway 41/10 intersection.

PROJECT GOALS

- ✓ Improve the safety, capacity, and travel time on Highway 10 and at the Highway 41/10 intersection for vehicles and non-motorized users.
- ✓ Construct a modern four-lane highway (two lanes in each direction) with a center median and trail connections along Highway 10.
- ✓ Promote school campus safety and accessibility.
- ✓ Minimize construction activities and land acquisition costs, impacts to properties, and impacts to existing utilities.
- ✓ Evaluate access modifications for properties and local street connections that make it safer and easier to get on, off, and across Highway 10.
- ✓ Evaluate noise impacts.
