# NON-MOTORIZED MULTI-USE TRAILS

*Trails are maintained April–November*

## Dakota Rail Regional Trail (DRRT)

Carver County's 12.5-mile multi-use corridor is a favorite of bikers and hikers for its beautiful views of Lake Waconia, Lake Waconia Regional Park and Coney Island, Crane Creek, Crow River, Goose Lake, prairie and farmland. Users of the Dakota Rail Regional Trail pass through the communities of Mayer and New Germany.

*Trail access and parking: Cities of New Germany, Mayer, and St Bonifacius*

## Southwest Regional Trail Connection (SWRT)

The SWRT is approximately 7 miles of a developing 13-mile trail that winds through portions of Chaska and Victoria. When completed, the trail will create a looping trail network between three trails.

*Trail access and parking: Adjacent to Victoria City Hall, Victoria Library, and Charlson Thun Community Bandstand.*

## Minnesota River Bluffs Regional Trail (MNRBRT)

The Minnesota River Bluffs Regional Trail in Carver County is approximately 8.5 miles. Much of the trail is located within a former railroad corridor and runs parallel to the Minnesota River along the southern border of the county. Points of interest include downtown Carver and Chaska, the Seminary Fen, Riverside Park, Depot Park and Athletic Park.

*Trail access and parking: Depot Park downtown Carver, Athletic Park and Ball Field, Western Chaska or the Chaska Levy Trailhead.*

## Trunk Highway 5 Regional Trail

East-west linking trail operated cooperatively with the City of Chanhassen, U of M Landscape Arboretum, City of Victoria and Carver County. The trail corridor will extend from the Lake Minnetonka Regional Trail in Victoria continuing to the eastern Carver County line which is approximately 10 miles.

*Trail access and parking: Lake Ann Park off Hwy 5 in Chanhassen*
