
HIGHWAY 212 PROJECT BENTON TOWNSHIP



PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Carver County, in partnership with Benton Township, the Cities of Norwood Young America and Cologne, and MnDOT are working together to identify and implement roadway improvements to Hwy 212 from Cologne to Norwood Young America. The objective of the project is to design approximately 5-miles of safety and capacity improvements along Hwy 212 between Hwy 34 on east side of the City of Norwood Young America to Hwy 36 on the west side of the City of Cologne. Planned improvements will repair pavement conditions and address safety and mobility concerns on Hwy 212 between Hwy 34 and Hwy 36 in Carver County.



Above drawing shows the recommended four-lane divided highway design with eastbound and westbound lanes separated by a center median ditch and roadside ditches on the outside shoulders of Hwy 212. Turn lanes are included at all public road intersections as well as reduced conflict intersections (RCIs) and a grade separated overpass at Hwy 51.
