

HIGHWAY 41/10 PROJECT



Carver County, in collaboration with MnDOT and the City of Chaska, is developing improvements along Highway 10/Engler Boulevard from Bavaria Road to Park Ridge Drive in Chaska. This project will improve safety, traffic flow, and travel time along Highway 10 and at the Highway 41/10 intersection for vehicles, pedestrians, and bicyclists.

Carver County will reconstruct Highway 10 into a four-lane highway (two lanes in each direction) with a center median from Bavaria Road to Crest Drive.

Other improvements include:

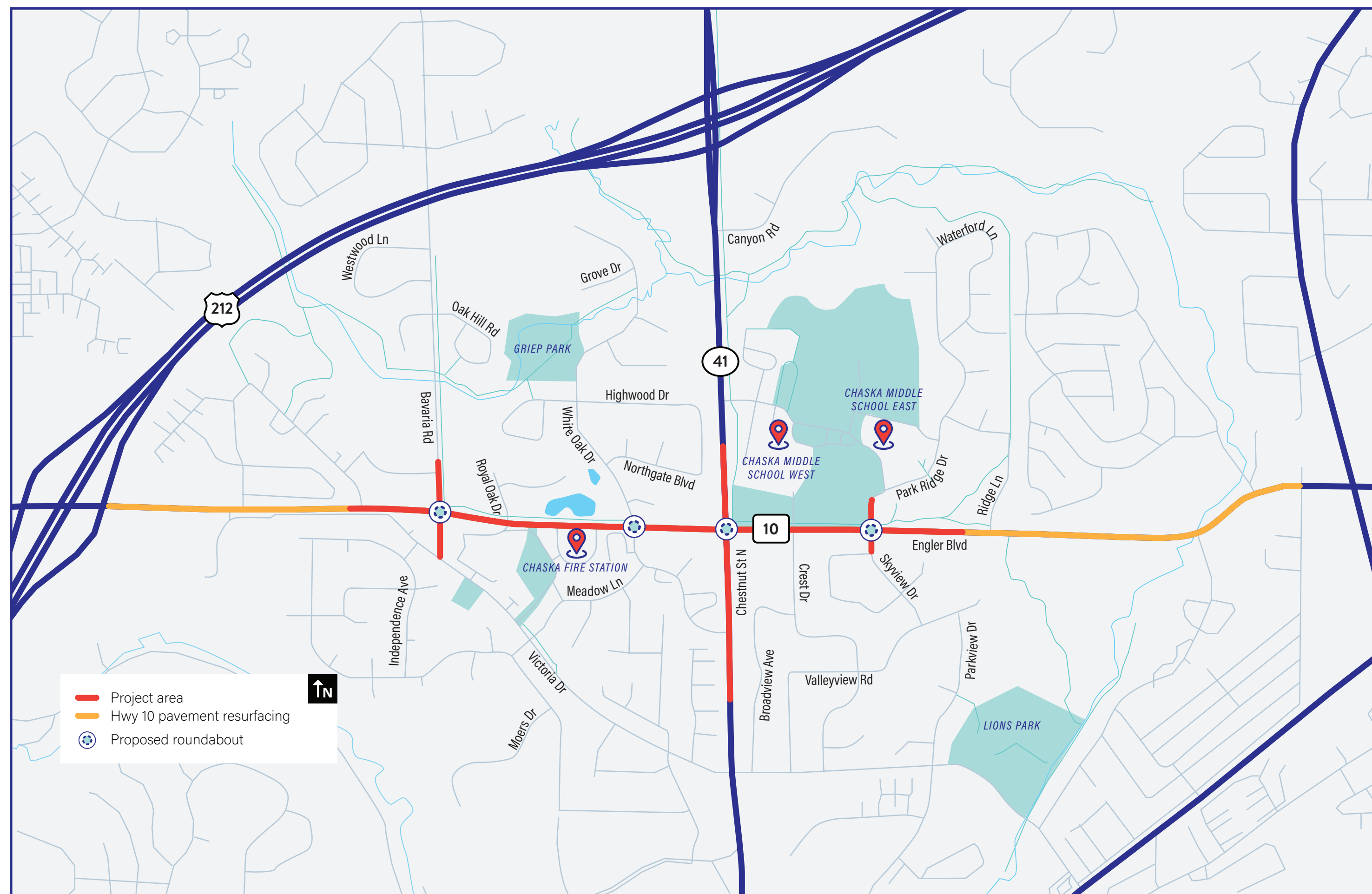
- » Roundabouts at Bavaria Road, White Oak Drive, Highway 41/10, and Park Ridge Drive
- » Pavement resurfacing from the Highway 212 interchange to Old Audubon Road
- » Trail connections along Highway 10, including from the Chaska Community Center to Ravoux Road
- » New City of Chaska Public Safety Campus

PROJECT GOALS

- ✓ Improve the safety, capacity, and travel time on Highway 10 and at the Highway 41/10 intersection for vehicles and non-motorized users.
- ✓ Construct a modern four-lane highway (two lanes in each direction) with a center median and trail connections along Highway 10.
- ✓ Promote school campus safety and accessibility.
- ✓ Minimize construction activities and land acquisition costs, impacts to properties, and impacts to existing utilities.
- ✓ Improve property access and local street connections to make it safer and easier to get on, off, and across Highway 10.
- ✓ Evaluate noise impacts.

PROJECT BENEFITS

- ✓ Safer road that separates oncoming traffic
- ✓ More travel lanes to handle traffic today and into the future
- ✓ Improved traffic flow
- ✓ More predictable travel time
- ✓ Better access to and from Highway 10
- ✓ More walking and bicycling options in the area
