Motion carried unanimously.

Sheriff Olson requested the Board adopt Resolutions in recognition of public safety employees.

He explained the first Resolution was to recognize 911 dispatchers who provide the first link to the emergency management response system. He indicated in 2006, over 57,000 calls for service were dispatched from the Emergency Center. He noted they also receive over 300 cell phone calls a month. Sheriff pointed out they have a very active Dispatch Center and stated he was proud to recognize these individuals for the work they do.

Sheriff encouraged citizens to call 911 even if it was not an emergency situation and indicated the dispatchers would be able to direct the call to the appropriate area.

He encouraged residents, if they have a voice over internet provider, to verify that those calls would be connected to the Sheriff's Dispatch Center. He also stressed the need for cell phone users to inform the dispatchers of their physical locations when placing calls to the Dispatch Center.

In recognition of National Corrections Week, Olson pointed out the Sheriff's Office maintains one of the safest and secure jails in the State. He stated they average 100 inmates a day and have 45 staff members. He noted the jail is recognized as one of the most progressive jails and explained the new fingerprint identification system they are utilizing to bring new technology to the jail.

Sheriff explained Law Enforcement Memorial Week was also coming up in May. He stated this Resolution was to recognize the law enforcement officers in the County and officers who died in the line of duty.

Chair Degler thanked Sheriff Olson for bringing to their attention the dedicated staff they have.

Resolution #34-07 Police Week 2007 On vote taken, all voted aye.

Jason Mielke, Land and Water Services, requested the Board approve Wm. Mueller and Sons' request to amend an existing mining operation on the Lundquist property in Dahlgren Township. He noted there would be changes from what the current CUP allows for. He indicated after two road projects have been completed, the processing activities would cease and the mining activities would continue to operate under the current conditions in place. He stated the applicant has agreed to widen the existing entrance and construct a by-pass lane at the pit location.

He indicated the Planning Commission held a public hearing and recommended approval of the request. In addition, Dahlgren Township recommended approval.

Ische moved, Lynch seconded, to adopt Findings of Fact and issue Order #PZ2007005 for the issuance of Conditional Use Permit #20070005, Wm. Mueller & Sons, Dahlgren Township. Motion carried unanimously.

Gary Bork, Community Social Services, requested the Board approve an agreement with eDocument Resources. He explained part of their 2007 budget included a technology imitative. He stated this was the first step to begin processing documents in an electronic format.

Ische moved, Maluchnik seconded, to approve the professional services agreement with eDocument Resources for the implementation of the Compass/OnBase electronic document management system. Motion carried unanimously.

Kevin Mass, Facilities, appeared before the Board to update them on the Public Works Headquarters storage project. He explained the proposed expansion of the semi-heated and cold storage areas. He noted the expansion of storage space follows the master plan that was approved for the original construction of the facility. He indicated they received the civil engineering plan yesterday and explained the site considerations that are still to be worked out.

Maas indicated they will submit the plan to Land and Water for their review but he did not anticipate they would need to amend the current conditional user permit. Following that review, he stated they would send the project out to bid.


Doris Krogman, Employee Relations, requested Board authority to offer the top Financial Services Division Director candidate a starting salary above the normal hiring range and additional vacation credit. She stated the Financial Services Director and Assistant positions have been vacant since late 2006, with another recent resignation making it critical to fill the position. She indicated they do have one highly qualified candidate with public sector experience and noted the salary range for similar counties.

Ische moved, Maluchnik seconded, to approve offering the top Financial Services Division Director candidate a starting salary up to Step 10 of the current range and some additional vacation credit in order to fill the position as soon as possible. Motion carried unanimously.

Lynch moved, Workman seconded, to adjourn the Regular Session at 10:08 a.m. Motion carried unanimously.



2007 Special Waste Collection Events

In 2006, 679 residents participated in the two Special Waste Collection Events and the following materials were collected: 1622 fluorescent lamps, 76 gallons of used antifreeze, 318 lead acid batteries, 1526 gallons of used oil, 860 used oil filters, 2840 tires, 920 electronics, and 715 appliances.

Two County-sponsored Special Waste Collection Events are being planned for 2007. The dates and locations for these events are as follows:

- 1. Saturday, May 5, 2007 from 8 a.m. to 12 noon in Norwood Young America at the Central High School parking lot
- 2. Saturday, September 15, 2007 from 8 a.m. to 12 noon in Norwood Young America at the Central High School parking lot

The fees to residents and the materials collected are the same as for last year. We will again be collecting tires, used oil, used oil filters, used antifreeze, fluorescent lamps, appliances, electronics, batteries, household hazardous waste, and scrap metal. We are using the same vendors as used for last year except for electronics recycling - Greenman Technologies of Minnesota, Inc. (tires); Retrofit Recycling, Inc. (fluorescent lamps); J.R.'s Appliance Disposal Inc (appliances); and Asset Recovery Corp. (electronics).

The Special Waste Collection Events have been very successful and have been very well received by residents.

BACKGROUND/EXPLANATION OF AGENDA ITEM:

Carver County has been a leader in the compost bin distribution program for the metro area. Environmental Services would like to continue the program in 2007 and begin the transition to distribution through retail outlets. Environmental Services has made arrangements to distribute bins at the Environmental Center as well as Lakewinds Market in Chanhassen.

The past bin distributions have attracted significant numbers of County residents that are new to composting. This has stimulated broader composting of food waste. By surveying past participants, we have found the bins to perform very well and meet or exceed expectations. Current owners of Home Composter bins are likely to remain dedicated bin users. Over all, the bins are perceived as providing good value.

The County will purchase bins for approximately \$32.50 and sell the bins for \$30.00 to residents. We anticipate selling about 400 bins. The sale price for the bins is based on a survey of past bin purchasers potential asking what they are willing to pay for a bin.

Carver County has been offering bins to residents since 1994 and demand for composting bins remains high.

The actual cost to the County will be approximately \$1,200 based on about 400 bins and some minor other expenses associated with the distribution. 



BACKGROUND/EXPLANATION OF AGENDA ITEM: The County Parks Department proposes partnering with the City of Chanhassen, City of Shorewood and the Shorewood Parks Foundation to create and off-leash dog area at Lake Minnewashta Regional Park.		
The updated 2002 Park Master Plan identified a site within the park boundary that could support and off-leash dog area. In 2005, a site plan for the off-leash dog area was developed with input from interested members of the public. Two alternate designs were proposed. The preferred Concept B was selected after public review and discussion. During 2006, additional work was done to raise funds and collaborate with partners for financial contributions to the project.		
The proposed financial contributions to the development of an off leash dog area at Lake Minnewashta Regional Park and commitment to on going operations and maintenance are stated below. The City of Chanhassen is contributing \$30,000 The City of Shorewood is contributing \$10,000 (\$5,000 from moneys donated by citizens to the Shorewood Parks Foundation and a \$5,000 match from the City of Shorewood)		
County Parks has \$5,000 budgeted, contributes in-kind services for the construction of the off leash dog area and will provide ongoing maintenance and operations of the off leash area.		
ACTION REQUESTED: It is recommended that the County Board authorize the County Board Chair and the County Administrator to sign the Agreements with the City of Chanhassen and the City of Shorewood for the development and financial contribution to create an off-leash dog area at Lake Minnewashta Regional Park.
