| | Key Theme A: Life expectancy has declined from 79 to 76. 1.2 million COVID deaths in the US. 159 COVID deaths in Carver County. Kidney, liver, diabetes, heart disease, stroke deaths all increased. Suicide, overdose, traffic fatalities also have increased. |
| | Carver County has room for improvement in HOUSING and EQUITY KEY THEME B: Residents feelings about the impact of social conditions on mental health |
| | KEY THEME C: Carver County is growing and changing, and growth is greatest among those 65+ (new and aging residents). Incidence of cancer, anxiety or panic, as told to Carver County residents by a health care provider, is up by 3.3% and 2.8% respectively from 2018 to 2023. |
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| Agenda Item 4 continues: | Substance use: 12-13% cigarette smoking, 3% vaping, 16.2% THC, 2.6% opiods, and 75.9% endorse alcohol (higher than surrounding counties and the U.S. as a whole) Commissioner Lynch shared that he is working on a marijuana ordinance, during discussion of legalization of marijuana. The homeless Point in Time (PIT) count statistics were shared: 49 people identified as homeless in Carver County, of which 13 were children and 26 were ages 25+.
