<b>4. New Business</b>	<p>a) Guest: Devarati Bhattacharya, Carver Resident, 4-H (see Handout) Youth Feel stretched in school life. They want to extend the conversation on mental health. 3 year plan for 4H is to integrate more mental health. Discussion question raised by Steph Combey to Devarati, is the mission to expand community outreach, support prevention efforts? How can we come together to expand our reach?</p> <p>4H is 9 clubs that serve different parts of Carver County, and Chaska is the area of greatest need. Youth Led, focusing on youth of color, robotics, animal science, and there are lots of opportunities for partnerships.</p> <p>b) Guest: Pat Stieg is here today to discuss the CHA (q 5 year) results for 2023, which is to guide the 5 year community health improvement plan for 2025-2029.</p> <p>Key Theme A: Life expectancy has declined from 79 to 76. 1.2 million COVID deaths in the US. 159 COVID deaths in Carver County. Kidney, liver, diabetes, heart disease, stroke deaths all increased. Suicide, overdose, traffic fatalities also have increased.</p> <p>Carver County has room for improvement in HOUSING and EQUITY</p> <p>KEY THEME B: Residents feelings about the impact of social conditions on mental health</p> <p>KEY THEME C: Carver County is growing and changing, and growth is greatest among those 65+ (new and aging residents). Incidence of cancer, anxiety or panic, as told to Carver County residents by a health care provider, is up by 3.3% and 2.8% respectively from 2018 to 2023.</p>	Information
