Due to the above, the Carver County Sheriff's Office was not able to host any snowmobile safety youth courses in conjunction with local conservation officers. However, the CCSO was able to send one deputy to a MN DNR Snowmobile Safety Instructor Certification training class in November of 2023. During a typical fiscal year, deputies would partner with DNR Conservation Officers for snowmobile enforcement/education, but deputies were unable to get on the snowmobiles due to poor snow conditions.
