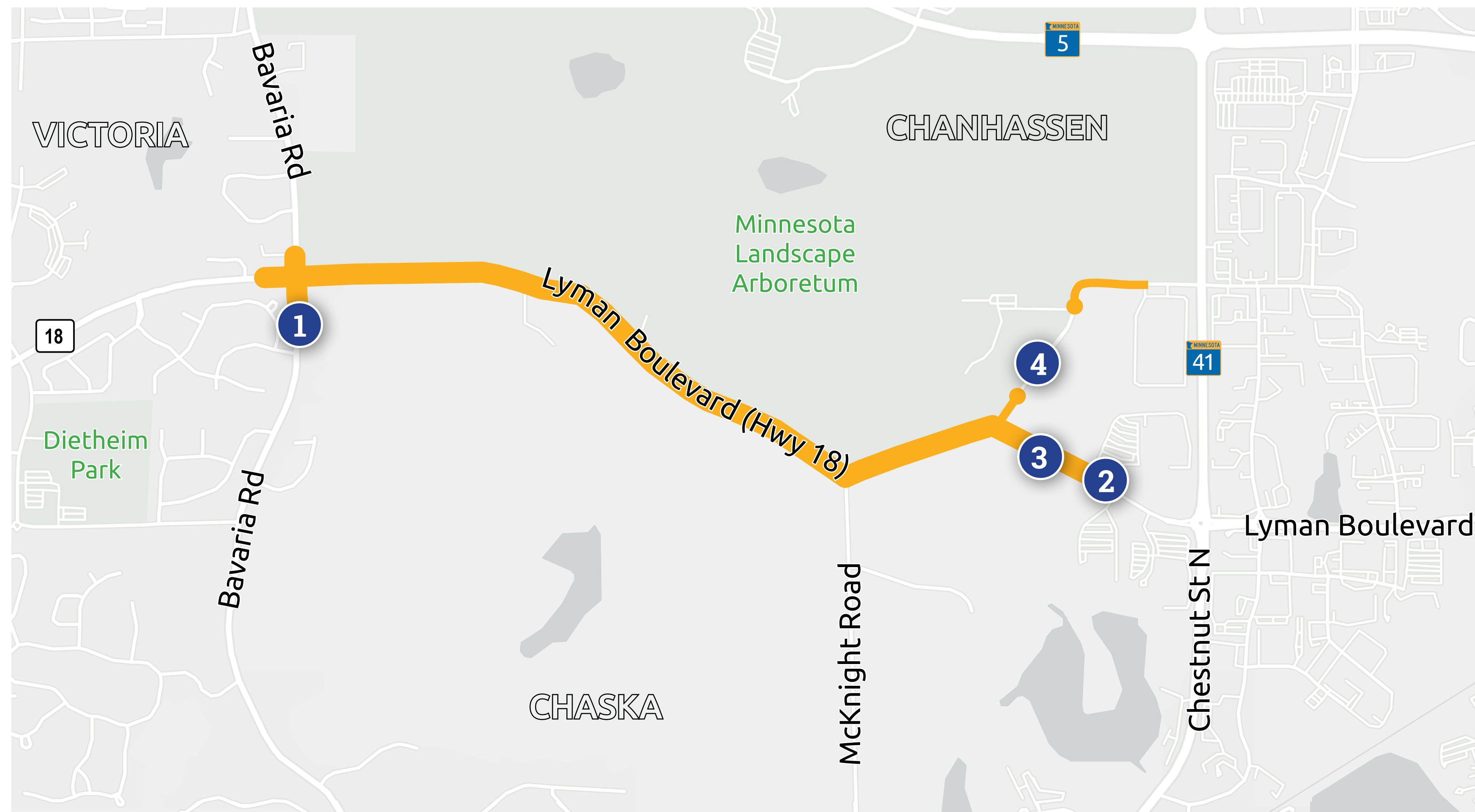


Highway 18/82nd St. Project Overview

The Highway 18/82nd St. Project will reconstruct the existing gravel road into a two-lane paved highway with curb and gutter and a paved multi-use trail on the north side of the road.

Project Improvements



- 1 A single lane roundabout at the intersection of Bavaria Rd. and 82nd St.
- 2 At the east end of the project area, a new segment of road will connect to the existing Lyman Blvd. in Chaska.
- 3 A new multi-span bridge will allow vehicles and pedestrians to cross over the restored creek and Chaska Ravine Trail. People who walk, bike, and roll will have a dedicated space on the north side of the bridge.
- 4 Cul-de-sacs will be constructed on the remaining segments of 82nd St.

Why is the road labeled Lyman Blvd. and Highway 18?

The current gravel road is 82nd St., however, at the completion of this project, the road name will change to Lyman Blvd. (Hwy 18).

Project Schedule



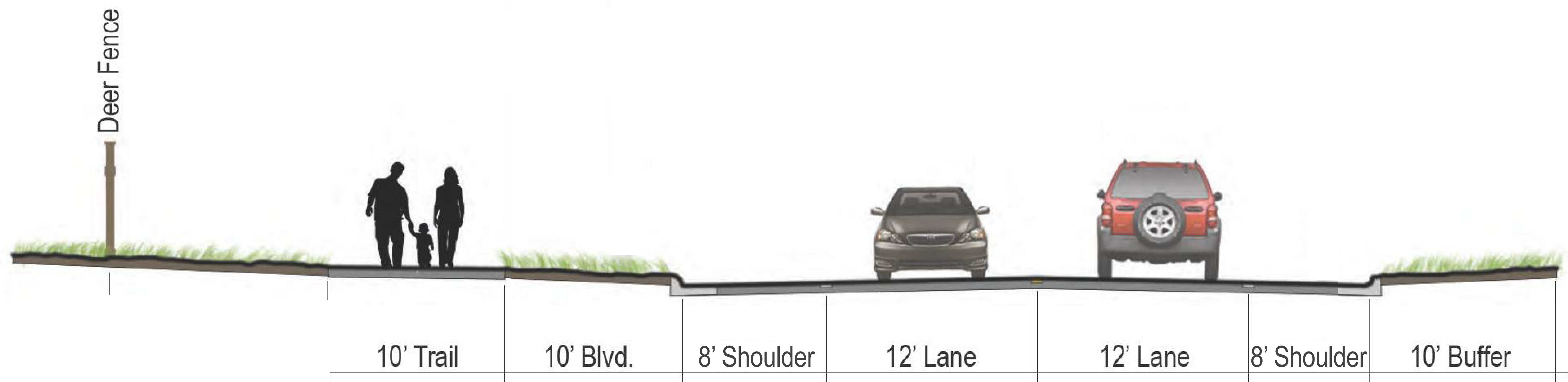
Public & stakeholder engagement will occur from 2023 through fall 2024

New Roadway Features - Curb & Gutter Roadway Design

Curb & Gutter Urban Roadway Design:

The existing gravel road will be updated to a paved surface with curb & gutter and a 10-foot-wide multi-use trail along the north side of the roadway. The new trail will connect to the existing paved trail on each end of the project area.

New Roadway Features - Bavaria Road Roundabout

Lyman Blvd. (Hwy 18) & Bavaria Rd Roundabout:

The project will construct a single lane roundabout at the intersection of Lyman Blvd (Hwy 18) & Bavaria Road (Hwy 13). The roundabout will help to:

- Reduce severity of crashes
- Reduce vehicle speeds
- Improve traffic flow without affecting capacity
- Improve connectivity for people who walk, bike or roll

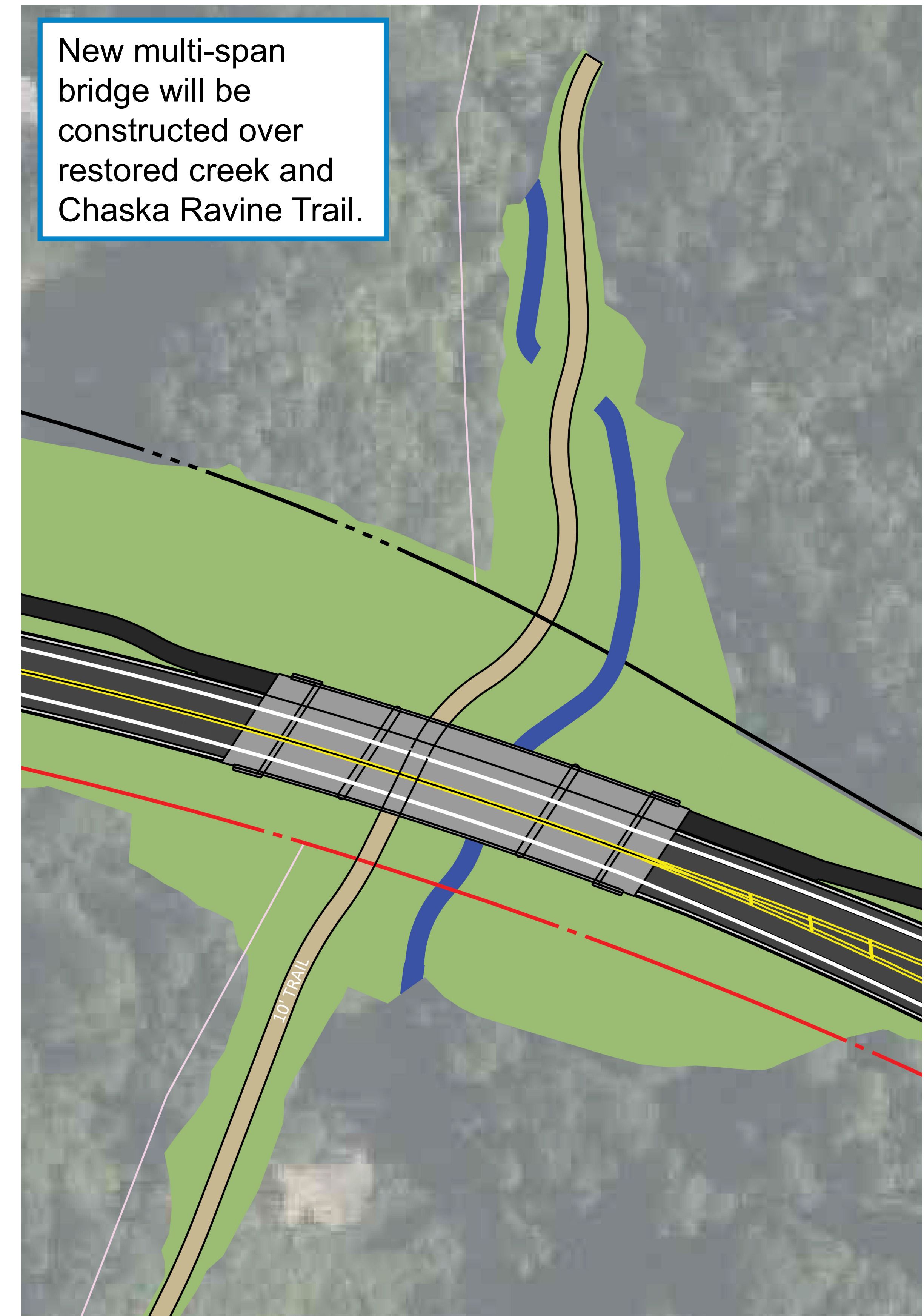
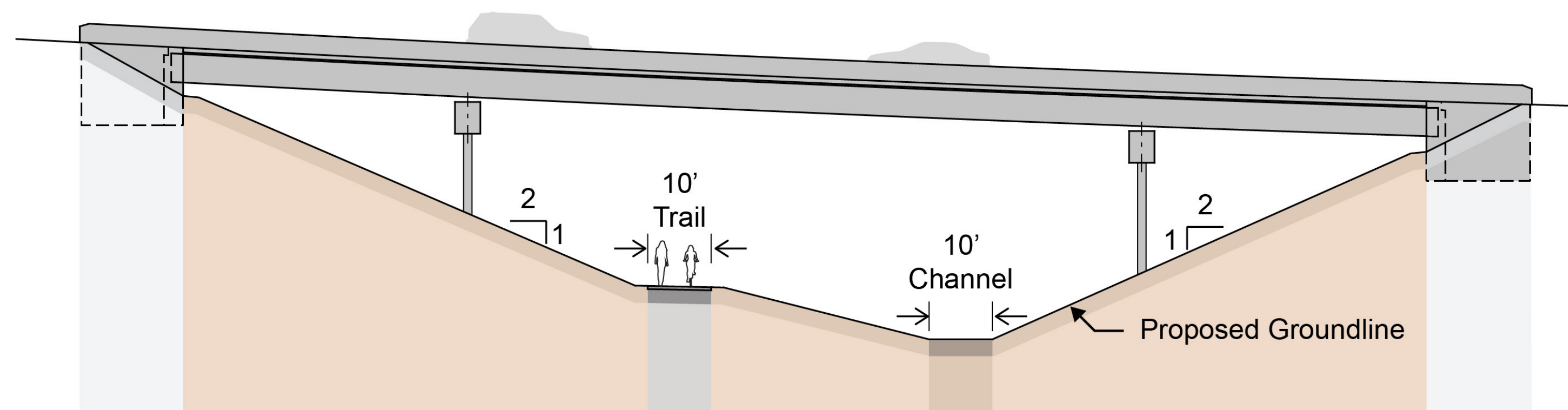


Chaska Ravine Trail Crossing:

A new multi-span bridge will allow vehicles and pedestrians to cross over the restored creek and Chaska Ravine Trail. People who walk, bike, and roll will have a dedicated space on the north side of the bridge that is separated from vehicle traffic by an 8-foot shoulder.

multi-span bridge with short abutments

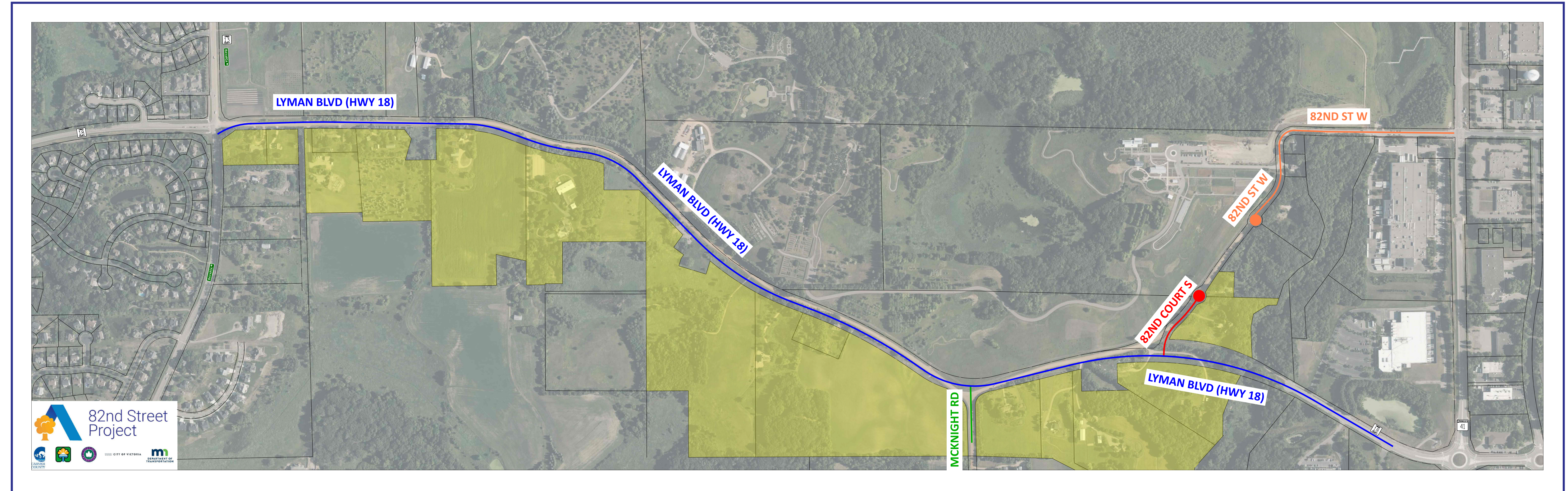


82nd St. Name Change



The 82nd St. Project includes severing 82nd St. south of the Minnesota Landscape Arboretum's Farm at the Arb access. As a result, after construction is completed in late 2025, a portion of 82nd St. will be renamed to Lyman Blvd. (Highway 18).

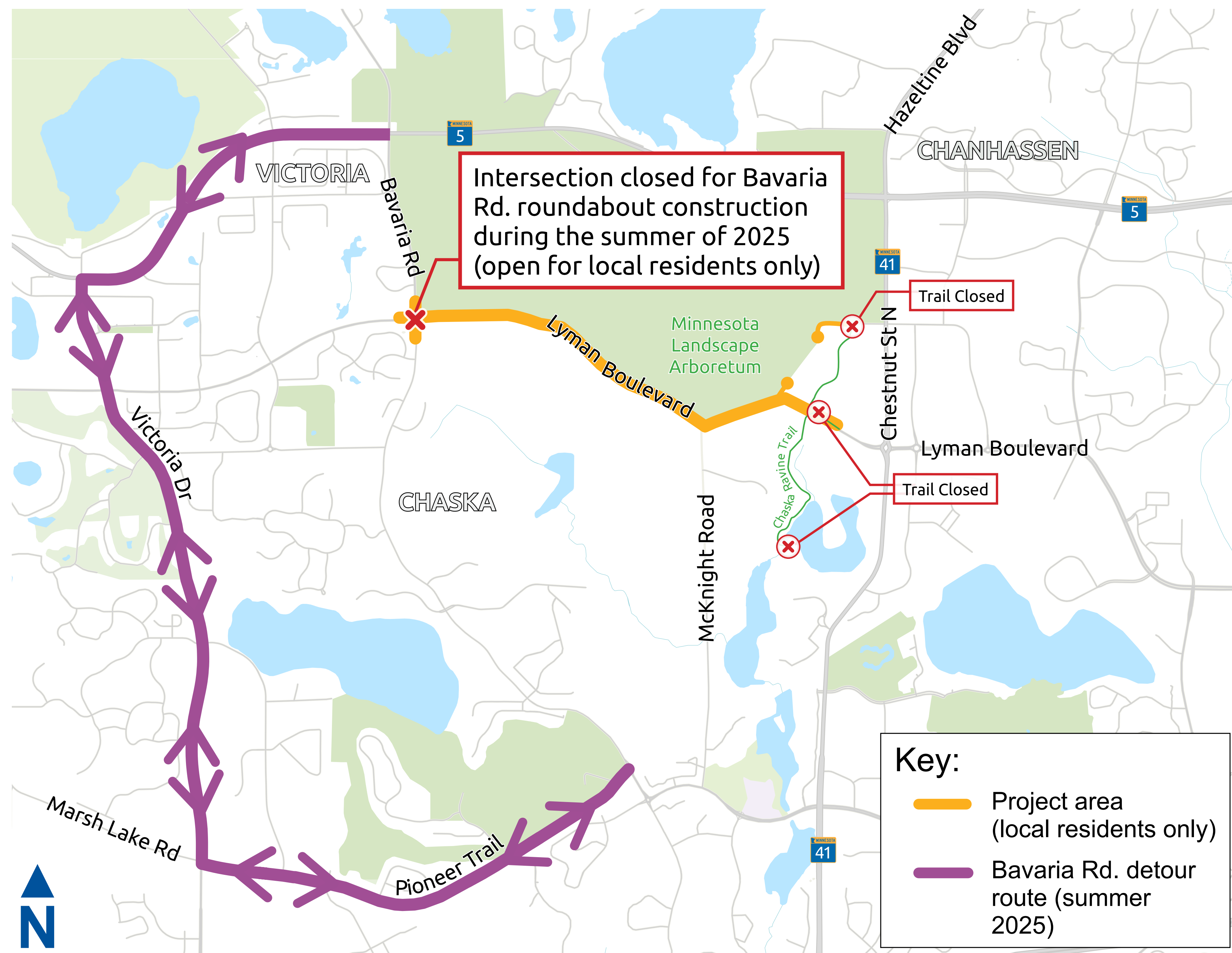

Highway 18/82nd St. Project - Construction Schedule



During the 2025 construction season, 82nd Street will be closed to through traffic. The roadway will remain open for local residents and temporary driveway closures will be communicated as needed. The Bavaria Road roundabout will be constructed during the summer months of 2025, and a detour route will be posted for Bavaria Road.

Summer 2025

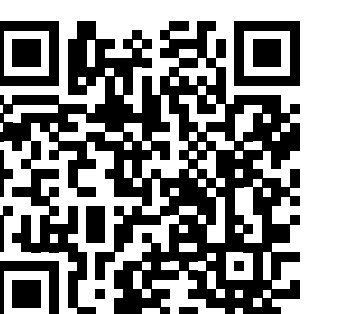
- Chaska Ravine Trail crossing
