Construction of the MN River Bluffs Regional Trail is expected to start soon! Tree clearing was completed in the spring and remainder of **the project is scheduled to be constructed this fall**. Construction work will include heavy equipment, gravel placement, paving, planting, and trail signs.

Where is the trail being built?

The trail will be installed along the former C&NW Railroad property through downtown Chaska and along Hwy 61/Chaska Blvd (see map on the back).
