- 2. Outside each separate sleeping area in the immediate vicinity of the bedrooms.
- 3. On each additional story of the dwelling, including basements but not including crawl spaces and uninhabitable attics. Smoke alarms being installed shall not be required to be hardwired where the alterations or repairs do not result in the removal of interior wall or ceiling finishes exposing the structure.

CARBON MONOXIDE DETECTOR REQUIREMENTS: (Minn. Stat. 299F.50)

Carbon Monoxide Detector shall be installed within 10' of all sleeping rooms.
