After-Hours Emergency Shelter Assistance can be accessed through the Mental Health Crisis Team and local law enforcement officers from the Carver County Sheriff's Office and Chaska Police. Funding for this type of emergency housing is made available from donations to the Salvation Army. Assistance is limited to individuals who do not have a vehicle or other transportation to a homeless shelter, and it is limited to one weeknight or weekend stay at specific motels/housing units in Carver County. Those receiving the vouchers are required to report to a Community Social Services office or case manager the following business day. The vouchers can be obtained after regular business hours from law enforcement officers or from the Mental Health Crisis Program.
