Agenda Item 4: Discussion of Mental Health Initiatives in the County: Discussion The Council had anticipated having a writer from the Star Tribune attend today's meeting. As the writer did not attend, we tabled most of the discussion around this topic. The Council did agree that Crisis Intervention Training for the city and county police officers in Carver County is an important topic. The Council agreed that Chief Knight (Chaska Police Department) would be contacted and invited to attend an LAC meeting later in the year. The Council also discussed inviting Sgt. Brady Juell to an LAC meeting. Sgt. Juell is the officer in charge of mental health training for the Chaska Police Department. The Council also agreed to contact the Barbara Schneider Foundation and invite them to attend an LAC meeting. The Foundation provides de-escalation training for a variety of agencies involved in responding to mental health crises. The Council co-chairs, Lisa Gjerde and Sam Deweese, will coordinate contacting the above noted individuals/agencies. **Roundtable Discussion:** Agenda Item 5: Lisa G. reminded the Council that the Jewish Mental Health conference is in October. Reminder Council reviewed last month's monthly summary of activities. Review Eddie discussed sharing WeCab information with other communities in Carver County. Currently, WeCab Discussion covers Ridgeview Health network sites and the communities of Chaska, Chanhassen, Carver, and Victoria. WeCab asks that interested communities make a request for service and Eddie would like to contact the

appropriate person in Waconia and Watertown to discuss the option.
